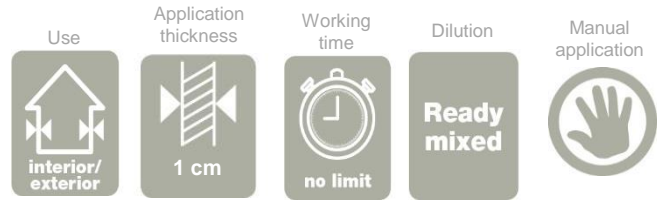

RECOMMENDATIONS

On soft or friable wood, it is advised to apply a wood hardener.

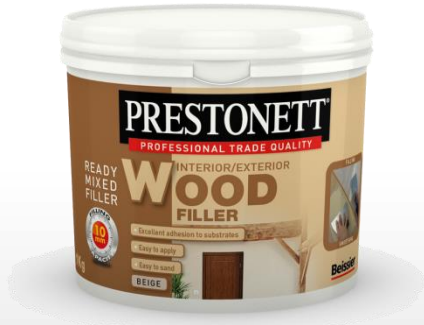
